Mineral fine plaster for lime press and glaze techniques indoors and outdoors



Material description



Material type: Jaeger Antiqua consists of long-seasoned slaked lime and a selected mixture of fine marble and quartz sand.

Intended use: Lime plaster for all exterior and interior surfaces. Jaeger Antiqua is an ideal smoothing plaster when a smooth and mineral coating is required, e.g. on historical buildings and in modern architecture. Jaeger Antiqua is also ideal as a painting base for curved surfaces and glazing techniques, for both exterior and interior use. Traditional sgraffito, relief and fresco techniques can also be easily executed with Jaeger Antiqua.

Technical application notes

Working method:

1. substrate preparation: Clean the surface carefully and remove loose parts. Consolidate highly absorbent substrates with Kronen Hydrosol Deep Primer. Moisten the hardened substrate. Prime surfaces (exterior and interior) with Jaeger Iso mineral primer.
2. filling: Jaeger Antiqua is applied in at least 2 layers with the Jaeger smoothing trowel or painter's trowel. Do not apply at temperatures below 5°C and above 35°C or in direct sunlight.
